


PacStaMgr – PACSystems Station Manager


Introduction

PacStaMgr is a new station manager tool for the Ethernet module. It provides support for both Ethernet and serial connection to the Station Manager, and allows the user to easily switch between these connection methods. Display from either connection is presented seamlessly in the same scrolling display.


For example, in the following figure the user manually issued the *tally v* command via an Ethernet connection to 10.0.0.2, then selected the Serial checkbox, and hit the return key to issue the same command through the serial connection (configured for COM1). The command prompt is used to indicate the connection method that was active when the command was issued.




The Setup menu provides access to the serial port and script configuration tools, as shown below.



The script configuration allows the user to select Standard Analysis, which mimics the PacsAnalyzer command sequence, or to select a user file. The user file is a simple text file containing station manager commands, with each command on a separate line. Commands that start with # or @ are ignored. Script configuration also provides execution control options. The Default Settings button sets the Run count to 1 and the delay to 0 milliseconds.



To run the script, click on the Run Script button, which then turns into a Stop Script button. As the script executes, the status bar displays the name of the script, the current run count for the script, and the current command being executed.



All settings are preserved in the Windows registry, to minimize the need for user setup the next time PacStamgr is run.
